



LIVING INDEPENDENCE FOR THE ELDERLY (LIFE)

Community HealthChoices is coming to your area in January 2018, but it is not the only program that can help you to remain in your community.

You may be eligible for a different program called Living Independence for the Elderly (LIFE).

What is LIFE?

LIFE is a program that serves eligible older Pennsylvanians in their homes and communities. LIFE uses local programs to pay for, manage, coordinate, and provide all your physical and behavioral health.

How do I know if I am eligible for LIFE?

If you are 55 years of age or older, the LIFE program may be an option for you. You must be nursing facility clinically eligible, financially eligible for Medical Assistance, reside in an area served by a LIFE provider, and be able to live safely at home or in the community.

What if I am already enrolled in CHC?

Anyone who is enrolled in CHC and qualifies for LIFE may move to the LIFE program. Also, you can choose to disenroll from LIFE at any time.
